CAN I ADD A FAMILY MEMBER TO MY HEALOW ACCOUNT?

Yes, to link a family member follow these steps:

- On the My Accounts screen, tap the Accounts button, tap add new Account
- On the select relationship screen, select the option that best describes your relationship to the person whose account is being added, then tap the Save button.
- Then you will set-up their account as you did yours

NB: Please be reminded this feature can only be done from the Healow app.
